



## CONDITIONAL OCCUPANCY REQUEST

The *Ohio Building Code* (OBC) and the *Residential Code of Ohio* (RCO) requires that a **VALID** Certificate of Occupancy be issued before any building or structure can be used or occupied. The certificate indicates the conditions under which the building shall be used. The building owner shall only use the structure in accordance with the valid Conditional Certificate of Occupancy.

A Conditional/Temporary Certificate of Occupancy can be issued upon request of the owner, if the building is safe and sanitary, that all life safety provisions (means of egress, fire protection (ie: fire sprinkler, fire alarm, etc.), including any special provisions (physical protection of the occupants), etc.) are maintained, and upon payment of a Conditional Certificate of Occupancy fee and any other outstanding fees at the time of the request.
